Parents:

If your child has a case manager, contact them about your child requiring home instruction or about switching them to our facility if they already have in-home tutors.

If you have not already done so, be prepared to provide documentation from a professional stating the reason for the extended absence.

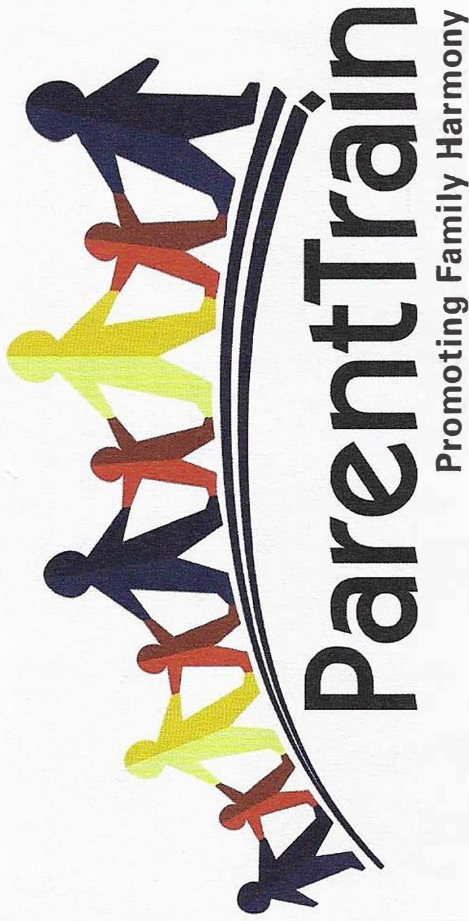
School Personnel:

Please be prepared to provide the name of the school district professional that will be our point of contact, this may include teachers for academic work, supervisor for payment contract, and/or special services case manager for IEP supports.

Home Instruction Hours will be based on need between the hours of 9:00am - 2:30pm, Monday through Friday. However, special arrangements are available when necessary.

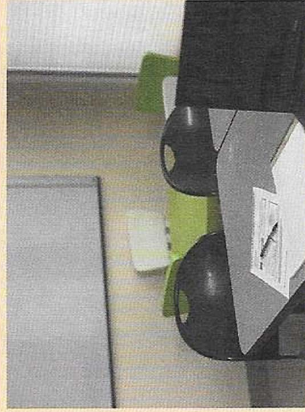

Home Instruction

Home instruction is the provision of one-to-one or small group instruction in the student's place of residence or other appropriate setting due to a health condition, need for treatment, court order or exclusion from general education for disciplinary or safety reasons.
